- DOWN: Orders, Policy, Information, Inquiry
- UP: Information, Questions
- UP & DOWN: All Informed, Provide Assistance, Solve Problems
- UP or DOWN: CHAIN NOT JUMPED

(Addressed as "Sergeant")







SERGEANT FIRST CLASS (SFC) (Addressed as "Sergeant")



MASTER SERGEANT (MSG) (Addressed as "Sergeant")



FIRST SERGEANT (1SG)
(Addressed as "First Sergeant")







SERGEANT MAJOR (SGM)
(Addressed as "Sergeant Major")



COMMAND SERGEANT MAJOR (CSM) (Addressed as "Sergeant Major")





WARRANT OFFICER

Warrant Officers are formally addressed as either Mr. or Ms. They can also be addressed as Sir or Ma'am. CHIEF Warrant Officers are addressed as CHIEF.




